## Health rate updates

Effective September 1, 2021, monthly Health premiums will increase to:

|        |                            |
|--------|----------------------------|
| Single | \$94.75 (\$4.20 increase)  |
| Family | \$189.50 (\$8.40 increase) |

Your rate increase is based on claims experience for the Health plan.

### NEW FOR 2022: HIGHER MAXIMUM FOR DRUG REIMBURSEMENT

Effective January 1, 2022, the annual maximum for drug reimbursement will increase from \$2,000 to \$2,500 per person per calendar year.

## NEW FOR 2022: GLUCOSE MONITORING

Effective January 1, 2022, Health plan coverage will be expanded to cover two types of glucose monitoring systems.

- **Flash Glucose Monitoring:** Plan will cover 80% of the cost of one **reader** every 36 months. Plus 80% of the cost of **sensors** up to a maximum of \$2,000 per calendar year. Eligibility requirement: Insulin use.
- **Continuous Glucose Monitoring:** Plan will cover 80% of the cost of one **reader** every 60 months. Plus 80% of the cost of **sensors and transmitters** up to a combined maximum of \$3,000 per calendar year. Eligibility requirement: Type 1 diabetes.



## ONE-TIME OPPORTUNITY!

### Do you need Dental or Travel coverage?

The Manitoba Public School Employees Benefits Trust is offering you a **one-time opportunity to enhance your benefits coverage**. This means you can add Dental and/or Travel coverage to your existing Health plan, for you and your eligible dependents, effective **January 1, 2022**.

**Dental coverage** reimburses:

- 80% of eligible basic dental services, and
- 50% of eligible major dental services
- combined **maximum of \$1,500** per person per calendar year

**Travel coverage** reimburses:

- 100% of eligible expenses related to unexpected emergency treatments during the first 90 days of any trip outside Canada

**New total monthly cost (including Health) beginning January 1, 2022:**

|        | Add Dental only | Add Travel only | Add Dental and Travel |
|--------|-----------------|-----------------|-----------------------|
| Single | \$154.25        | \$119.50        | \$179.00              |
| Family | \$325.50        | \$239.00        | \$375.00              |

### HOW TO CHANGE YOUR COVERAGE

Complete the attached application form and email or fax it to the address at the top left side of the form before **November 30, 2021**. If the application form is not returned, Dental or Travel coverage will not be added.

**No late applications will be accepted.**

If elected, Dental and/or Travel coverage will start on **January 1, 2022**.

Note that if you add Dental and/or Travel during this enrolment period, it becomes a package deal and **you will not be able to cancel either benefit at a later date** without terminating Health coverage as well.

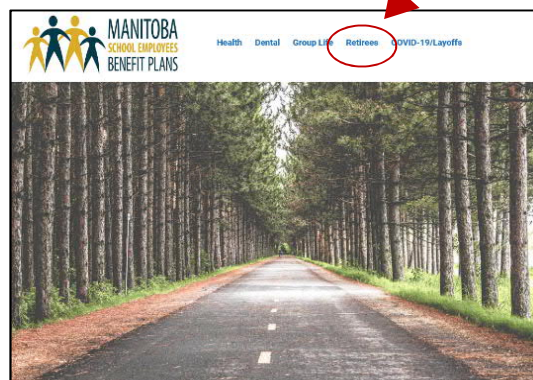
